Group Overview

ASL Marine Holdings Ltd. is a dynamic offshore and marine company listed on SGX Mainboard since 2003. ASL Marine is principally engaged in shipbuilding, shiprepair and conversion, shipchartering and other marine related services, catering to customers from Asia Pacific, South Asia, the Middle East and Europe and Australia.

ASL Marine owns four shipyards in Singapore, Indonesia (Batam) and China (Guangdong) providing a comprehensive range of marine engineering services spanning myriad sectors/ industries. It has a young fleet of 186 vessels comprising mainly barges, towing tugs, Anchor Handling Tugs, Anchor Handling Towing/Supply vessels, ROV and chemical tankers.

Batam yard

Our Batam yard, operated under the name PT ASL Shipyard Indonesia, commenced its operation in 1997.

The close-knit operation of the Singapore and Batam yard has allowed synergies in our business that provide customers with one-stop marine engineering facilities. Besides the close synergy from streamlining processes between the two shipyards will enable us to offer competitive prices without compromising on our quality standards, reliability and turnaround time. Tailoring to customers' requirement, production works can be carried out simultaneously in both yards to bring along substantial cost saving due to higher efficiency.

Our shipyard in Batam is well-equipped for repair and conversion of all types of vessels including Tanker, Bulk Carrier, Container Vessel, Offshore Support Vessel, Jack-up Rig, Semi-submersible Rig, FSO and FPSO. Our facilities include a 135m x 33.5m (inner width) floating dock and 3 graving dry docks (300,000 dwt, 60,000 dwt & 20,000 dwt).

Competitive Advantages

Enhanced docking capacity - The 300,000 dwt graving dry dock in Batam, measuring 340 metres in length, is currently the largest in Indonesia capable of accommodating larger vessels up to Capesize and Aframax.

Proven track record – ASL Marine has over the years built a creditable track record in performing repair works on Jack-up oil rig, FSO, Tanker, Bulk Carrier, Container Vessel, OSV, Dredger and Construction Vessel.

Strategic location - Our shipyard in Batam is strategically located along major shipping routes.

Experienced Management Team - An experienced Board and management team with extensive experience in their respective area of responsibilities.

Outlook and Future Plans

With oil prices trading above US\$100 per barrel, we believe confidence for the offshore O&G support sector to remain high, especially in offshore exploration and development activities and expect more upgrading and conversion works to be in the pipeline.

We will be utilising our existing yard facilities/resources in Batam to focus on offshore fabrication works (e.g. turret, top side modules, accommodation modules, jacket, etc), conversion of high-value vessels (e.g. FSO, FPSO) used mainly for offshore oil & gas related projects and repair and upgrading of offshore drilling vessels (e.g. jack-up rig, semi-submersible rig, lift-boat).
